# WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS May 22, 2024

### **EXODUS 6:1-13**

#### INTRODUCTION:

- 1. **Exodus 6.1:** "Then the Lord said to Moses"
  - a) The children of Israel complained to Moses. (Ex. 5.20,21)
  - b) Moses complained to God about the way Israel had been treated. (Ex. 5.22,23)
- 2. In verses 1-13, God reminds Moses of His plan and gives him a message to take back to the children of Israel and Pharaoh.

#### I. A MESSAGE TO MOSES

- A. **Exodus 6.1:** "Then the LORD said to Moses"
  - 1. Moses asked a question of accusation. (Ex. 5.22)
  - 2. Moses asked a question of aggravation. (Ex. 5.22,23)
- B. God provided three answers.
  - 1. God provided a chronology. (Ex. 6.1; cf. John 13.7)
  - 2. God provided a methodology. (Ex. 6.1; 3.19)
  - 3. God provided an identity. (Ex. 6.2-5)
- C. It is a message to us.
  - 1. God gave Abraham a son in His time. (Gen. 15.3; 21.1,2)
  - 2. God promises to avenge in His time. (Rom. 12.19; Isa. 5.18,19; Ezek. 12.22)
  - 3. God promises the return of Jesus in His time. (2 Pet. 3.3,4,8; Acts 17.31)

## II. A MESSAGE TO ISRAEL

- A. **Exodus 6.6:** "Therefore, say to the children of Israel"
  - 1. **Exopus 6.6:** Moses is to tell them who God is. (cf. Ex. 3.14.15)
  - 2. **Exodus 6.6:** Moses is to tell them what God will do. (cf. Ex. 12.12; Deut. 7.8)
  - 3. **Exodus 6.7:** Moses is to tell them who God will be. (cf. Deut. 4.20,34)
  - 4. **Exodus 6.8:** Moses is to tell them where they will go. (cf. Ezek. 20.5,6)
- B. How do the children of Israel receive the message?
  - 1. **Exodus 6.9:** "they did not heed Moses." Why?
  - 2. **Exodus 6.9:** "because of anguish of spirit and cruel bondage."
- C. It is a message to us.
  - 1. **EPHESIANS 2.4-7:** He tells us who He is.
  - 2. **EPHESIANS 1.7:** He tells us what He did.
  - 3. **EPHESIANS 2.8:** He tells us who He will be.
  - 4. **EPHESIANS 2.19:** He tells us where we will go.

#### III. A MESSAGE TO PHARAOH

- A. **Exodus 6.10:** "Go in, tell Pharaoh king of Egypt"
  - 1. **Exodus 6.11:** "Let the children of Israel go out of the land" (cf. Ex. 5.1,2)
  - 2. Exodus 6.12: Moses expressed apprehension. (cf. Ex. 4.1,10)
  - 3. **ExoDUS 6.13:** God gave Moses and Aaron a command.
- B. It is a message for us.
  - 1. We are expected to bring people out of the bondage of sin. (2 Cor. 2.14-16)
  - 2. We may feel inadequate, and our experiences have only reinforced our self-doubt.
  - 3. But God gives us a command to do so. (Matt. 28.18,19)
