#### WEDNESDAY NIGHT BIBLE CLASS JULY 31, 2024 Exodus 11:1-9

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

1. At the end of the plague of darkness, Pharaoh still did not see the light but threatened Moses with death if he ever came into his presence again. (Ex. 10.28)

2. **EXODUS 10.29:** "So Moses said, 'You have spoken well. I will never see your face again." Moses then left the presence of Pharaoh in "great anger" (Ex. 11.8).

3. God's dealing with Pharaoh was about to come to an end with one last plague.

## I. PREDICTION

- A. God said something to Moses.
  - 1. He told Moses what was about to happen.
    - a) God will bring one last plague on Pharaoh and Egypt. (Ex. 11.1)
    - b) Pharaoh will let Israel go. (Ex. 11.1; 5.2; 6.1; 8.8.28,29; 9.27-30; 10.8,24)
  - 2. He told Moses what he was to do. (Ex. 11.2)
- B. God did something for Moses.
  - 1. God gave Israel favor among Egypt.
    - a) God promised it. (Ex. 3.21,22; Gen. 15.14)
    - b) Moses commanded it. (Ex. 11.3)
    - c) Israel obeyed it. (Ex. 12.35,36)
  - 2. God gave Moses favor among Egypt. (Ex. 11.3; 12.36)

## **II. EXPLANATION**

- A. God explains the nature of the plague.
  - 1. It was a plague that would be revealing. (Ex. 11.4,5; 5.2; 8.10; 9.14,29)
  - 2. It was a plague that would be widespread. (Ex. 11.5)
  - 3. It was a plague that would be heart wrenching. (Ex. 11.6; 9.14)
- B. God explains the limitation of the plague.
  - 1. God has excluded Israel from most of the plagues. (Ex. 11.7; 8.22; 9.4,26; 10.23)
  - 2. Why? To show Pharaoh that Israel is God's people. (Ex. 4.22,23; Hosea 11.1-4)
- C. God explains the effect of the plague.
  - 1. ExoDUS 11.8: "your servants shall come down to me and bow down to me"
  - 2. Exodus 11.8: "Get out, and all the people who follow you!"
  - 3. Exodus 11.8: "After that I will go out."

# **III. APPLICATION**

- A. The word of God is powerful.
  - 1. **Exodus 11.4:** "Thus says the LORD"
  - 2. When God speaks, astonishing things happen. (Ps. 33.8,9; 105.31-35)
- B. The people of God are exclusive.
  - 1. EXODUS 11.7: "that you may know that the Lord does make a difference."
  - 2. Out of humanity, God has a special people who are His. (Ex. 19.5; Hos. 1.8,9)
  - 3. Most of the world will be surprised. (Matt. 7.23; Luke 13.23-30)
- C. The anger of God is punishing.
  - 1. The plagues were an expression of God's anger. (Ps. 78.49-51)
  - 2. Is it wrong to be angry? (Ex. 11.8; Eph. 4.26; Matt. 5.22; Jonah 4.4)
